Named after New York University founding father Albert Gallatin, Albert is an electronic information service that provides self-service access to a wide variety of student information through NYU Web.

For applicants, Albert offers a portal through which you will be able to check the status of your application for admission. Students who are offered admission will reply to the offer through Albert, and will be able to view their financial aid award online.

If you attend NYU, Albert is the gateway to your personal information and academic history, including courses, grades, transcript information, and much more.

Submitting Test Scores to NYU

NYU allows students to submit a variety of official standardized test scores to be eligible for admission, as alternatives to the SAT or ACT. Examples include AP and IB scores and a number of country-specific examinations. Only transfer applicants who have already completed one full year of college/university coursework may be exempt from submitting standardized testing. Please be aware that if you should choose to submit an alternative form of testing other than the SAT or ACT, it may take some time before such tests are processed. As a result, it may appear that your standardized tests are not marked as "complete" on your Application Status menu. Once your alternative form of testing has been reviewed by an admission officer and cleared to meet our eligibility requirements, the status of your testing will change to "complete."

Admission Decision Release

We expect that all admission decisions will be released on your Application Status link on December 15th starting at 5pm Eastern Time for Early Decision I candidates and on February 15 after 5pm for Early Decision II candidates. Admission decisions for Regular Decision candidates will be available sometime on April 1st after 5pm. Please ease your pop up blocker to off before checking for your decision. Decisions will not be released over the phone until 5 days after decisions have been released via the Application Status link. Admission decisions for Spring 2016 transfer students will be e-mailed beginning in mid-November while decisions for Fall 2016 transfer students will be e-mailed beginning in early May.
