

Steinhardt Doctoral Dissertation Grant

Grants Awarded: Up to \$1,000

Grant Proposal Deadline: March 1 by 5:00 PM

The Doctoral Dissertation Grant competition provides support for the completion of the dissertation. Doctoral candidates with approved dissertation proposals, and in good academic standing, are invited to apply for the grant to support data collection directly related to their dissertation work. Proposals will be judged on the basis of their scientific merit and feasibility.

Requirements:

The proposal must contain 1) complete application cover page; 2) dissertation proposal with approval signatures; 3) a current CV; 4) line item budget and budget narrative; 5) letter of support and commitment from the student's mentor indicating willingness to work with the student in the completion of work; 7) time line for completing the dissertation

- Awardees are required to submit a final report on progress due July 1st of the year following the award.

Submission:

One copy of the materials should be emailed as a single PDF to John Johnson (john.johnson@nyu.edu) in the Steinhardt School's Office of Research. Applications are due on March 1st at 5:00 PM. Late applications will not be accepted.

Eligibility:

- Open to any Steinhardt doctoral student with approved dissertation proposal
- Students may only receive only one internal dissertation support award (either the Steinhardt Doctoral Dissertation Award or Mitchell Leaska Dissertation Award) one time during their studies
- All awardees must provide the Office of Research with UCAIHS Approval prior to disbursement of funds.
