

Steinhardt Doctoral Fellowship Proposal Summer Development Award

Grants Awarded: Up to \$2,000

Grant Proposal Deadline: March 1 by 5:00 PM

The goal of the program is to support doctoral students in the development and writing of a fellowship or grant proposal, which will be submitted to external funding sources in the next academic year.

Proposals will be judged on the basis of their scientific merit and fit with the selected external funding source. The students must be enrolled in a doctoral program at New York University's Steinhardt School. Preference may be given to proposals to external agencies that are underway and for which feasibility is demonstrated.

Fellowship Proposal Development Process:

Students will meet throughout the summer (2012) as a group to write, read, and develop individual proposals, which will be submitted to external funding agencies (NIH, NSF, IES, Ford foundation, etc). Support will be provided as hourly compensation. Attendance at the monthly summer meetings will be mandatory as these meetings are run in workshop style to help you develop your proposals while working with members of our office as well as with other funded students.

Requirements:

The proposal must contain 1) complete application cover sheet; 2) one-page statement of the student's research experience and progress toward degree completion; 3) a current CV; 4) the name and source of at least one external funding opportunity to which the developed proposal will be submitted in the next academic year; 5) letter of support and commitment from the student's mentor indicating willingness to work with the student in the development of his/her external funding application. Students must have at least 10 hours a week of available student employment time to commit to the program (e.g. students with weekly commitments of 20 hours to another NYU project are not eligible).

Submission:

One copy of the materials should be emailed as a single PDF to John Johnson (john.johnson@nyu.edu) in the Steinhardt School's Office of Research. Applications are due on March 1st at 5:00 PM. Late applications will not be accepted.

Eligibility:

- Open to any Steinhardt doctoral student
- Students may only receive this award one time during their studies
