Doctoral candidates with approved dissertation proposals are invited to apply for the Pre-Doctoral Summer Research Grant to support data collection, writing, and/or travel directly related to their dissertation work. Grant amounts will be up to \$1,000.

Instructions: Fill out and return this form to Office of Student Affairs with the required signatures no later than March 6, 2009. Include three copies of the following items with this application:

- Project description (250 words, no abbreviations or citations) written for an academic audience but not experts in the applicant's field. It should identify the specific research question, the research being undertaken or type of information or data to be acquired, and the broader significance of the project. All terms should be accessible to the general reader. The project description should also include a proposed budget indicating how the research grant will be used.
- Statement of support from your Committee Chair.
- Applicant's curriculum vitae.
- Current copy of applicant's NYU transcript.

Incomplete applications and applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered. Doctoral candidates may qualify for this grant only **once**.

Recipients of the NYUSteinhardt Pre-Doctoral Summer Research Grant must submit, no later than September 15, 2009 a report /narrative to Associate Dean Patricia M. Carey at the address above. This report should briefly summarize (1-2 pages) the summer research experience and its outcome. In addition, recipients present his/her findings at the Dean's Grants to Support Student Research Colloquium in mid-October, 2009.

In accepting a Pre-Doctoral Summer Research Grant, I give NYUSteinhardt permission to publicize my abstract and research findings in an appropriate format. I further agree to report my research findings at the Dean's Grants to Support Student Research Colloquium during the Fall semester following completion of my research. I certify that I have not conducted my proposed research prior to June 1 of the year in which I will apply for the grant.
