## New Student Scholarship Application

**\*\*\*New Master's and Advanced Certificate Applicants ONLY\*\*\***

Scholarships at NYU Steinhardt are awarded based on academic merit and financial need. To receive consideration for any financial aid (which includes scholarships), applicants must submit their Application for Admission and the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) no later than February 1 for the fall/summer semesters or November 1 for the spring semester. Canadian and Mexican citizens applying for the Graduate Education Scholarship for North American Scholars do not need to submit the FAFSA.

### ► Opportunity Scholarships

These scholarships were established to recognize and recruit students from under-represented groups, including African-Americans, Latinos/Hispanics, and Native-Americans, who demonstrate high academic ability. Opportunity Scholarships are for full-time study and provide partial-tuition support that is renewable in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

- *NYU Opportunity Fellowship* – New York University established this scholarship in 1986 to help increase the number of outstanding students in graduate degree programs at NYU.
- *Deans Opportunity Scholarship* – This scholarship helps hundreds of top students further their education.
- *Health Professions Opportunity Scholarship* – For students planning to enroll in a NYU Steinhardt health related program.

### ► HBCU, HSI and Tribal College Scholarship

Graduates of Historically Black Colleges and Universities, Hispanic Serving Institutions and Tribal Colleges planning to pursue full-time study are eligible for consideration. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

### ► Graduate Education Scholarship for North American Scholars

The first of its kind within NYU Steinhardt, these partial-tuition scholarships recognize the academic accomplishments of Canadian and Mexican citizens who enroll for full-time study. No FAFSA required to apply.

### ► Jonathan Levin Urban Education Scholarship

This scholarship provides tuition assistance in order to attract talented teachers seeking the opportunity to develop their ideas and skills. Eligible candidates must be current teachers holding initial/provisional certification. Applicants should be enrolling part-time in one of our master's degree programs leading to professional/permanent certification. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

### ► Returned Peace Corps Volunteer Scholarship

Recognizes the contributions that Returned Peace Corps Volunteers made abroad.
