

Enrollment Mismatch Hold

If a student has an "Enrollment Mismatch" listed in the Albert Student Center's Holds box, the student may be taking less credits, than he/she had originally planned to enroll.

The student needs to either:

1. Enroll in the number of planned credits
2. Or if taking less credits, complete the online **Anticipated Enrollment form** in the Albert Student Center.

Below are the steps. Once completed, Financial Aid can pass the award.
