Description:

The ASD Nest Staff Grant Program offers the opportunity for a team or an individual to obtain funding for a project to be implemented in the New York City Department of Education's ASD Nest Program in the 2014-15 academic year.

Purpose:

The purpose of the ASD Nest Staff Grant Program is to *stimulate* the development of innovative ideas and/or applications that address the strengths and challenges of our students in their elementary, middle or high school ASD Nest classrooms. Grant winners will *share* these ideas and applications at the Third Annual ASD Nest Program New School Year Kick-Off in late August, 2015.

Grants awarded:

- Four (4) **Collaborative Grants** of up to \$1000 each for teams of two or more applicants. *Grantees will present an interactive presentation at Kick-off.*
- Ten (10) **Individual Grants** of \$200 each. *Grantees will prepare a poster for Kick-off.*

Eligible applicants must:

- Work in an ASD Nest program as either a teacher or related service provider
- Represent different disciplines (Collaborative Grant awardees)

Time frame:

- *September 30, 2014:* Applications due
- *October 15, 2014:* NYU announces winners and awards grants
- *June 30, 2015:* Grantees submit project report and expenditure report
- *Late August, 2015:* Grantees present their projects (presentation or poster) at the Third Annual ASD Nest New School Year Kick-Off
