

The WorkForce 2000 Pre-RN Program is a two-year program that helps students complete the high school coursework they need in order to pursue a career in nursing. The program provides unique, practical opportunities through fieldwork and hands-on experiences helping students to gain insight into the expanding career options for nursing. Interested WorkForce 2000 students must complete an application and meet the eligibility criteria.

Students interested in pursuing a career in nursing must first apply for the WorkForce 2000 benefit during the registration period.

- If you receive the benefit, at the WF2000 orientation you can apply for the Pre-RN program **ONLY** if you meet the below requirements:
 1. Student will be a rising junior or senior in high school
 2. Have at least an 80 average and maintain an 80 average for the duration of the program
 3. Complete all application components by the deadline.
 4. Must commit to the full length of the program: 2 full years for rising juniors and 1 full year for rising seniors. This includes attending the Pre-RN open house: four full weeks of summer classes and select Saturday classes beginning in the fall.

The Pre-RN program is a highly competitive and selective program and application does not guarantee acceptance!

Is this the 6 week summer working program?

No, WorkForce 2000 is a 1 year academic program.

What is the program schedule?

1 year for all students! July 2017-June 2018

Summer Programming from July—Aug (Mon-Fri)

Fall Programming from Sept-June (Select Saturdays)

Can my student only participate in the summer or only participate in the fall session?

To take full advantage of what the program offers, we encourage a full year of student commitment; weekdays from July to August and select Saturday's from September -June. Please contact a WF2000 staff member with specific questions regarding scheduling.

Can my child take classes at another college campus?

No, all classes take place at NYU located at NYU's Silver Center, 31 Washington Place, New York, NY 10003 each session.

Is transportation offered?

No, but this is a great opportunity for your child to learn how to commute around the city independently.

Are students given metro cards?

Students are given travel stipends to cover the cost of a monthly metro card for the summer only.

What if my child has to attend summer school, has religious commitments, or other obligations?

We can work with you but you have to let us know as soon as possible!

My family will be on vacation for the entire month of July and August, can my child still participate?

No, students will not be excused for vacation.

Will my child receive college credits?

Although we are unable to offer college credits your child will develop an invaluable set of skills such as social skills, life skills, and academic and study skills.

I have two children that qualify for the WorkForce 2000 benefit, the child who was accepted is no longer interested in participating, can I switch the benefit to my other child?

Yes, if your child is eligible, on the bottom of your benefit status letter you can submit your request, in writing, to switch the benefit. To find out more information please call 212-564-2220

Do I have to pay for this program?

By law a member with a child over the age of 13, participating in WorkForce 2000 program will receive a W-2 form for the value of the benefit.
