NYU Steinhardt will provide up to 5 scholarships of \$12,500 each year to Teach For America alumni. To receive consideration applicants must:

- ❖ Apply and be accepted to one of NYU Steinhardt's master's degree or advanced certificate programs for the fall or summer semester for full-time study (spring applicants are not eligible).
- ❖ Submit Application for Admission and the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) no later than February 1.
- ❖ Submit the Teach For America Alumni Scholarship application by March 1.
- ❖ Be an alumnus of Teach For America by the time of enrollment.
