

DEPARTMENT OF NUTRITION, FOOD STUDIES & PUBLIC HEALTH

SCHOLARSHIPS

Students in the Department of Nutrition, Food Studies & Public Health may be eligible for certain scholarships established by professional organizations and individuals. These scholarships are limited both in number and in the amount of money they provide.* Application deadlines are usually in the Spring semester for awards during the following academic year, but there are exceptions. Scholarships are available in four categories:

I. Scholarships administered by the department.

II. Scholarships requiring the department's nomination to an outside agency.

For both of the above, DEADLINE FOR COMPLETE APPLICATIONS IS MARCH 3, 2008. Applicants must:

- be enrolled in NYU's Department of Nutrition, Food Studies & Public Health during the applicable academic year
- be of at least sophomore standing; graduate students are also eligible
- meet the organization's eligibility requirements
- complete the required application
- interview (if required); this is arranged by the department

III. Scholarships administered by an outside agency.

Students must meet the organization's eligibility requirements and apply directly to the agency; obtain application forms at the department if a supply is available, or write directly to the agency for information and forms; note application deadlines set by the agency.

* Funds received from these scholarships may be considered income and must be declared by students receiving financial aid, and are deducted from the total financial aid package. Some funds are deducted directly from tuition bills.

I. SCHOLARSHIPS ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT

- **KAPPA OMICRON NU (Alpha Rho Chapter)**

This scholarship is administered by Kappa Omicron Nu, a national honor society for individuals working or studying in the field of "home economics" (nutrition and food students are eligible for membership). Membership in the organization, a separate application and 2 letters of recommendation are required. Decision is based on scholastic excellence, previous work experience, community involvement and dedication to the field. Applications are available in the department. - **ANDRE AND SIMONE SOLTNER FOOD EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is sponsored by The American Institute of Wine & Food—New York Chapter and is available to individuals interested in pursuing or furthering a career in the area of food, be it in service, production, historical studies or distribution. All applicants must reside in New York State or Northern New Jersey and must fulfill the following criteria:

- Submit a typed, double-spaced essay no longer than 650-700 words explaining why the scholarship will be beneficial to the applicant
- Submit a resume
- Submit two letters of recommendation from:
 - A food industry professional;
 - A previous employer or educational program or character reference (non-family)
 - Be at least 18 years old
- Submit an official transcript in a sealed envelope from the most recent institution of higher education attended (where applicable)

Award winner(s) may be required to attend the annual AIWF award ceremony.
